CHECK-IN AND INDUCTION

Once you arrive at the centre you'll be guided through to the self check in area. Here you'll need your 'booking reference' to register your arrival and input any final details

Within 30 minutes of your check in, the Go Skydive team will call you through to the induction room where the customer service managers will give you the low down on what to expect throughout the day.


TRAINING CENTRE AND KITTING UP

20 minutes before your jump you'll be called through to the kitting up area. Here the ground crew team will assist you with jump suits (Trinity t-shirt on top), goggles and a leather hat. You'll then be fitted with a safety harness before your specialist training begins.

The pre-jump training session is conducted by highly qualified instructors. This session will last approximately 10 – 15 minutes and will give you the instructions required for your tandem skydive.

DEPARTURE ZONE

The departure area is adjacent to the airfield and is your last stop before take-off. Here you'll meet your instructor as you wait for your flight to be ready. Go Skydive operates from a fully operational airfield so for your safety you are not allowed onto the runway at any time. Once your flight is ready your instructor will escort you.



FLIGHT UP

Your instructor will escort you to the plane and once inside they will secure your harness to theirs and will then depart.

This aircraft has been refitted to specific requirements for tandem skydiving. It is the fastest tandem skydiving aircraft in the UK and will get you to your jump altitude in 8 -12 minutes.

TANDEM SKYDIVE

Once the flight has reached altitude you and your instructor will move towards the door for the next part of your experience which is the skydive itself.

The high adrenaline freefall starts as you and your instructor jump from your chosen altitude of either 10,000ft or 15,000ft.

This is amazing – you will literally fall through the air and rush towards the earth at approximately 125 mph – if you've chosen to jump from 10,000ft this will last approximately 30 seconds or 60 seconds if you're jumping from 15,000ft.

The rush is spectacular and is often described as being transported to another world. You won't be able to hear your instructor at these speeds, but you will feel him tap you on the shoulder which is your signal to move your arms into the freefall position that you will have practiced.

PARACHUTE SKYDIVE

At 5000ft your tandem instructor will deploy the parachute, this will slow your rate of descent to approximately 30mph.

You may feel as though you are being pulled backwards but you are just slowing down as the canopy produces the wind resistance needed to slow you down for landing. This journey down to the landing area is magical, you'll now be able to speak to and hear your instructor as you enjoy the calm of the parachute ride compared to the rush of freefall.

As you come into land you'll bring your legs up into the landing position that you will have practiced in your pre-jump training. You can now congratulate yourself and your instructor!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please be aware that this is a weather dependent activity. We may find out in advance, or on the day, that extreme weather means we are not able to run the event. This decision is out of our control and at the discretion of GoSkydive. Therefore, if the event cannot continue, we will do our utmost to let you know before you arrive (please keep your mobile phone on you), but the decision could be made with very little notice. If we cannot go ahead on the 14th July, your skydive will be rescheduled for a time that suits you.

WHAT TO BRING/PREPARE

Make sure you wear comfortable clothing with your arms and legs covered and lace up trainers. On the day you will be given a Trinity t-shirt to wear for the challenge. Failure to wear the correct clothing set out by the Go Skydive may result in you not being allowed to jump. **Due to Coronavirus, you must wear fabric gloves, a mask and a tubular/bandana/duff during your full skydive experience.**

TRAVELLING TO OLD SARUM PARK

BY CAR

Go Skydive is located at Old Sarum Airfield, which is near Salisbury on the central South Coast. Go Skydive is easily accessible from the South West, the South East and Central England.

BY TRAIN

Salisbury has a main line railway station with trains direct from London, Oxford, Bristol, the South Coast and the West. The venue is just a short taxi journey (10 mins) from the Salisbury station.
